Booking Conditions

If Mothers' Union is able to offer you a holiday, we want you, your family and those who go after you, to have a good time. For this reason all applicants are asked to agree to the following conditions:

Before the holiday

Your application will need to be supported by the sponsor who has put your name forward for a holiday. They will be asked to read through your application form and to complete a separate form confirming their support of your application. Your sponsor may be contacted by the AFIA representative to clarify any aspect of your application.

During the holiday

- Only those named on the application form may attend the holiday – no visitors may stay in the accommodation overnight. Visitors must leave the site no later than 8pm.
- The holiday residence should be treated with respect and left in the condition it was found.
- Site regulations must be adhered to. Site staff and members of the public should be treated with respect so that everyone has an enjoyable holiday.
- Children should be supervised appropriately at all times.
- Smoking is not allowed in the caravan.
- Dogs, cats or any other pets are not allowed in the caravan except registered guide dogs.
- Any damage should be reported to the Diocese of Llandaff AFIA contact person named on the application form or any person named within the caravan.
- If serious problems develop during the holiday, the Diocese of Llandaff AFIA contact person and your sponsor should be advised.
- Mothers' Union – Diocese of Llandaff reserves the right to ask any person not adhering to these conditions during the holiday to leave the caravan.
